One workshop will be entitled "European Union Foreign Affairs Journal Workshop", as EUFAJ contributes to the success of this event - with a later publication and real "Crème cassisée", the fruit liquor which was at the beginning of the ECJ's Cassis-de-Dijon case and the Single Market in 1978/9.
