



CATHERINE MAIA is a Professor of public international law at the Lusófona University of Porto (Portugal), and a visiting professor at Sciences Po Paris and the Catholic University of Lille (France). In addition, she is an international law consultant and a researcher at the Geneva Academy of International Humanitarian Law and Human Rights (Switzerland) and at the Centro de Direito Internacional (Brazil). Author of several publications (*Le statut international de la province angolaise du Cabinda à la lumière du droit international public*, Pedone, 2015; *La protection des prisonniers de guerre en droit international humanitaire*, Bruylant, 2014), her main areas of research are the protection of human rights, international criminal law and constitutional law.
