Hans-Jürgen Zahorka works since 2003 at the headquarters of LIBERTAS – European Institute GmbH. The former Attorney-at-Law and head of a foreign chamber office has been since many years in European functions: as Member of the European Parliament (there also as its first *Rapporteur* on the Uruguay Round of GATT which led to the foundation of the WTO), as Member of TEAM EUROPE (experts' network for discussions on behalf of the EU Commission) and of GROUPEURO (1996-2002, when the Euro was introduced). The – multilingual - university lecturer in European Law, Business and Studies in various countries was since 1997 also Government Advisor on behalf of the EU, UNDP and World Bank, but also directly contracted, in many states and regions – always as a convinced European, besides acting as investment advisor for private or public-private partnership clients. He founded EUFAJ in 2009 of which he is the Chief Editor. Having delivered various publications (approx. 80) mostly on European and international

subjects, he can be the nightmare of Eurosceptics and anti-Europeans in all kinds of discussions within the EU, but also a door-opener for European values and opinions in third countries.
